Amber has been trained (in English) and is usually quite responsive to commands. She's gentle and curious and has lived around kids and even a cat - who Amber keeps trying to convince to play with her. She's good on leash and usually returns quickly when allowed to run free in the fields or forest.

Like most Aussies Amber loves attention, being engaged mentally and learns quickly. She's not afraid of noises or the doorbell ring. She loves being caressed and talked to.

An important challenge for Amber and her newfound owners is that she has an elbow dysplasia which is causing her to limp slightly. This has been stabilized with medication and she is still able to enjoy life, run and have fun with other dogs. But it could progress over time. Her current owner could cover the cost of continuing medications. What is most important to us is that Amber can have the best life that her condition allows for as long as possible,

ideally with a companion who makes her life fun even if she can't exercise as intensely as other Aussies.
